The purpose of the trip is to: Encourage participation in various activities through an experiential environment. Helps promote lifelong participation in a range of physical activities.


Date: **May 30th, 2018** Cost per student: **Donations to Georgetown Food Bank (Donated goods or \$) Please leave at the Centennial Office**
