ELEMENTS OF RISK:

1. Bumps and bruises
2. Sprains and strains
3. Broken bones

By choosing to take part in this activity, you are accepting the risk that you/your child may be injured.

The chance of an injury occurring can be reduced by carefully following instructions at all times while engaged in the activity.

If you choose to participate in Jungle Sport on June 4-8, you must understand that you bear the responsibility for any injury that might occur.
